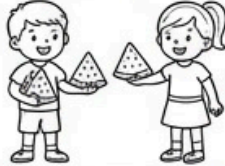

- 1.) Tim has 3 watermelon slices. Sara gives him 2 more slices. How many watermelon slices does Tim have?



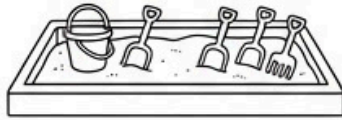
